Pricing

The price for the goods will be as stipulated on the website at the time you place your order. Accessibility

We offer a complimentary ticket to anyone requiring a full-time carer and ask that you provide proof of disability - via email is fine - which then goes on file so we don't have to repeatedly ask you for this.

Proof accepted is:

- Front page of DLA / PIP
- Front page of Attendance Allowance letter
- Evidence that registered severely sight impaired (blind)
- Recognised Assistance Dog ID card

Please buy the ticket/s you require (not the carer's). If you do choose to camp in the canvas/caravan area, the online booking system will ask you if you require a camping pitch within the disabled persons camping area.

Then forward your ticket confirmation email to info@towersefestival.com and we will issue a complimentary ticket (same type) to your carer. We will need their name, postal and email addresses please.

Artists

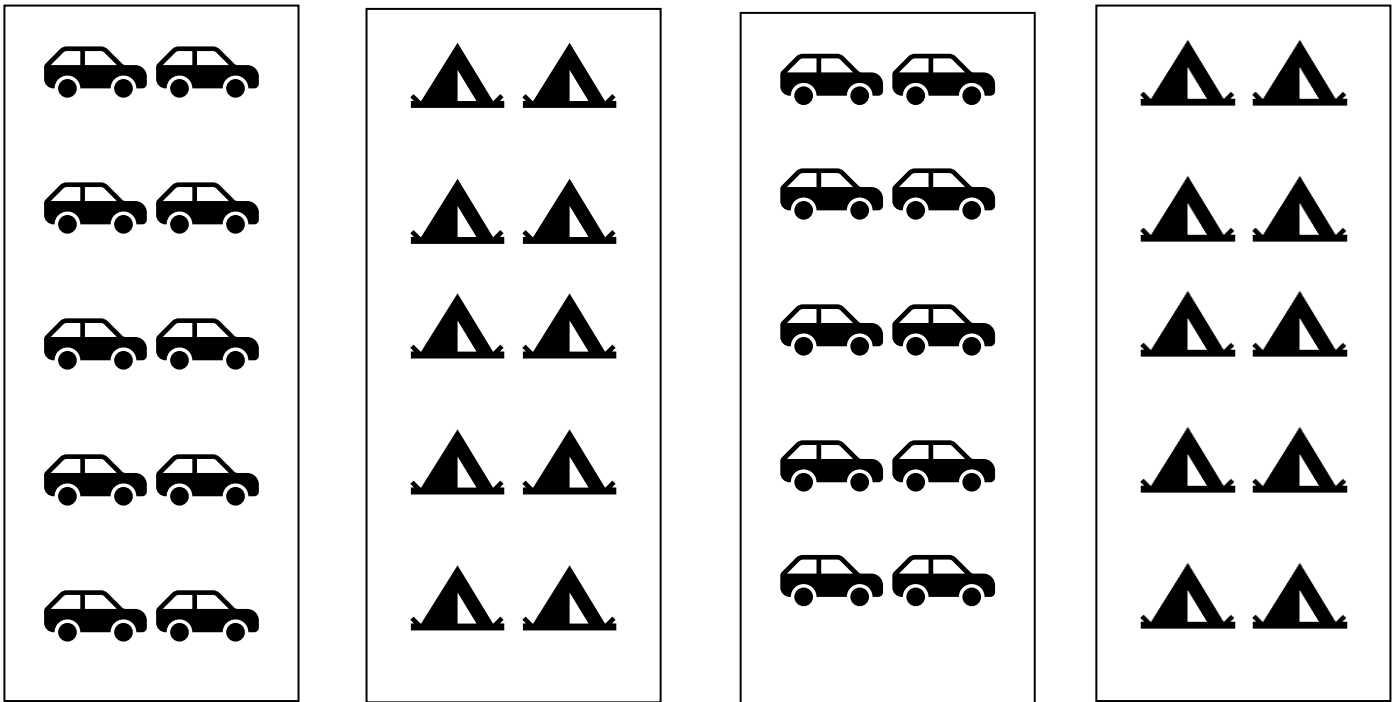

Camping - changes to improve safety on the site.

Fire Safety recommendations tell us that cars parked immediately adjacent to tents and live in vehicles is a potential danger.

We have taken the advice and made a small change to the camping and vehicles arrangement.

If camping in a tent we have created camping areas with vehicle areas opposite for your safety. Your car can now be parked NEAR you but not immediately adjacent.



Caravans and live in vehicles will be parked round the perimeter of the site with any towing vehicles parked nearby.

Friends and family of caravaners and live in vehicle owners may pitch tents adjacent to caravans and live in vehicles. Caravan and live in vehicles may not pitch in tented areas.

Once parked, your car or towing vehicle should stay in its parking spot. If you choose to drive off the site during the Festival, on your return you will be asked to park your vehicle in the Free Car Park near Gate 1.

Returning or access to the site will be from 6pm Monday 27 August. If needed before please go to Stewards' Office.

Children's (5-11yrs) Tickets

Available when booked at the same time as Adult tickets only.

Includes camping.

Under 5s go FREE and do not need a ticket.

Subject to availability.

Concession Tickets (Adult Weekend tickets only)

Available for Students, Senior Citizens (60+) and people claiming Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA).

Proof of entitlement must be shown on collection please.

Camping NOT included (can be purchased, subject to availability).

Available on Tiers 2 and 3. Full price from Tier 4.

Subject to availability.

Day Tickets

Cover all events on the relevant day (subject to space), for Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

You can collect your ticket/s from 9am on Friday 24 August 2018.

Camping NOT included. (can be purchased - permitted on the night of the Day ticket bought). Please buy these night camping tickets at the same time as your Day tickets.

Discounts

Our 10 for 9 offer applies to Adult Weekend non-camping or camping tickets only - if you buy 9 tickets you get another ticket free. **NB** - There can be no mixing of ticket type or camp sites.

Dogs

We are unable to accommodate dogs* on any area of the Site.

* Dogs to assist people with disabilities will be admitted to all venues including the Festival Green.

Festival Green Tickets

The Festival Green is an area on Site with plenty of space for people to come and take in a few hours of the Festival. There are a variety of performance shows around the Site. These are included in the Festival Green gate price. This ticket is valid for events around the Festival Green and in The Headless Horseman (Festival Green Bar), subject to space, from 10am until 11.30pm each day. Tickets available from mid-2018 online (until midnight before each day valid) or from Bizzie Lizzie Florist, Thame and on the day at the Festival Box Office. Subject to availability.

Photographs in Printed Publicity, Visual and Audio Promotion

Ticket holders consent to their inclusion in printed publicity, visual and audio promotion of the Festival. There will be no payment in cash or tickets for the use of any such photograph.

Resident Weekend Tickets

These are for residents of Thame & Towersey only.

Available 1 February – 19 August 2018 inc.

x2 Adult, x2 Youth (12-17yrs) x2 Children (5-11yrs) mix maximum per household.

NB – orders are monitored and those made in excess of above quantities or from areas outside of Thame and Towersey will be cancelled and monies returned.

Refunds

Not available on Day tickets.

Refunds on Weekend tickets with/without camping will be given consideration on written request before 1 June 2018 and will be subject to a 50% administration charge.

NO REFUNDS on any tickets from 1 June 2018.

NB – once tickets have been bought at a certain price, there will be no refunds of balance difference on any other ticket option offered.

Weekend Tickets

Cover ALL programmed events from Friday to Monday. Subject to space and availability.

Does not include camping (camping can be purchased, subject to availability).

Wet Weather

In the event of wet weather some Festival Green events will be moved, retimed or even cancelled. See Information notice boards for details.

Youth (12-17yrs) Tickets

Available when booked at the same time as Adult tickets only (30yrs + / NOT Adult Concessions).

Limited to x2 Youth tickets per booking.

NB - If camping is required the Adult must be booked into the same camp site as the 2 Youths.
